Update On Mict Accreditation Status: ACC/2012/07/689

Incus Data was first formally approved as an Education and Training provider by the ISETT ETQA in 2002. The ISETT ETQA later became part of the MICT SETA. Since then, we have been accredited and re-accredited by the MICT SETA a number of times.

Our 2018 accreditation status was valid until 26 August 2020. As our accreditation expired during the Covid-19 lock-down, the MICT SETA did not schedule re-accreditation visits. An online system was created to handle accreditation applications.

After initial problems with the online system, we were able to submit the documents for re-accreditation on 6 November 2020. When we requested feedback in 2021 on the status of our application, we were informed that there was a backlog of applications.


On 18 August 2021, the MICT SETA scheduled a virtual accreditation visit. The evaluator was unable to access their online system, and we had to provide her with the documents again, as well as additional documents that she requested.

In November 2021 we objected to a request for an OHS certificate, on the basis that it is not relevant for virtual training. All our training is presented virtually, and our staff are working from home. On 20 December 2021 we were informed that the current policy only allows for blended learning and assessments. We have requested information on how to appeal this policy. It should be noted that virtual training and assessments are conducted internationally, and the QCTO policy is clearly out of date.

We continue to pursue this matter, but only to facilitate our clients' ability to claim back SDL levies. Our position on the relevant SAQA unit standards remains unchanged: the standards are of extremely poor quality. We will not apply them in the design of our course content, or use them as a basis for determining competence.
